School Schedule:

- School timings for the bus students are 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and for the On- footers 9:00 a.m. to 12:15 p.m.
- For any queries or problems parents can meet the teachers only on Saturdays between 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.
- No child will be allowed to leave during the school hours unless prior permission is taken.

Dress Code:

- The students should be sent to school in proper uniform.
