



# Alphabet Fun

In English, we have a set of letters in a fixed order.

There are 26 letters in English alphabet.

These 26 letters make up the alphabet family.

We write these 26 letters in two ways:

**Capital letters:** A B C D E F G H I J K L M N O P Q R S T U V W X Y Z

**Small letters:** a b c d e f g h i j k l m n o p q r s t u v w x y z

The letters **Aa, Ee, Ii, Oo, Uu** are called **vowels**.

The other letters are called **consonants**.

**Alphabetical Order :** The order in which we recall all the letters of the English alphabet family, is the alphabetical order.

**Example:** When we write **a b c d e**, all the letters are in alphabetical order.

When we write **a d p c**, the letters are not in alphabetical order.

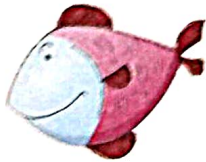
