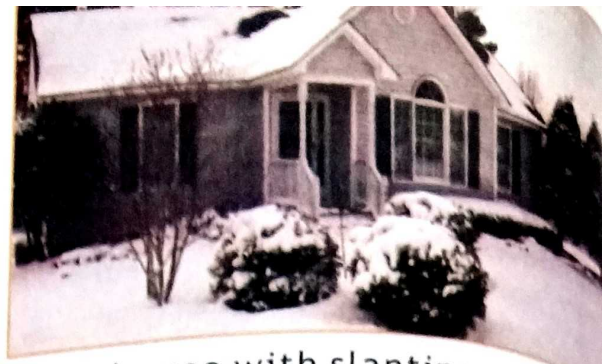


Houses With Slanting Roofs
