Adjectives

A word that describes a noun or a pronoun is called an Adjective.

It is also known as a describing word.

Adjectives are of 3 kinds:

1. Adjective of Quality → It describes colour, shape, size etc.

Eg. tall, green, clever etc.

2. Adjective of Quantity → It describes the amount.

Eg. much, many, little etc.

3. Adjective of Number → It describes the number or position.

Eg. six, ninth, first etc.
