

Mosquitoes are small flying insects responsible for spreading diseases like yellow fever, dengue, and malaria. They can breed in tiny amount of water. It is only the female mosquitoes that bite animals and people, causing itching and irritation. Male mosquitoes do not bite.



Lice are generally of two main types – chewing or biting lice and sucking lice. They grow on the human scalp, eyebrows, and eyelashes. They feed on human blood and their bites cause itching. They have very keen sense of smell. An adult louse can live on a person's head up to 3 to 4 weeks.



Termites are also called 'white ants'. Compared to ants, they have softer bodies. They feed on dead plants, trees and wood. They can cause damage to furniture, buildings, crops, and forests. They never sleep and have sense organs.
